Breckenridge Ski Resort is operated under a special-use permit with the White River National Forest.

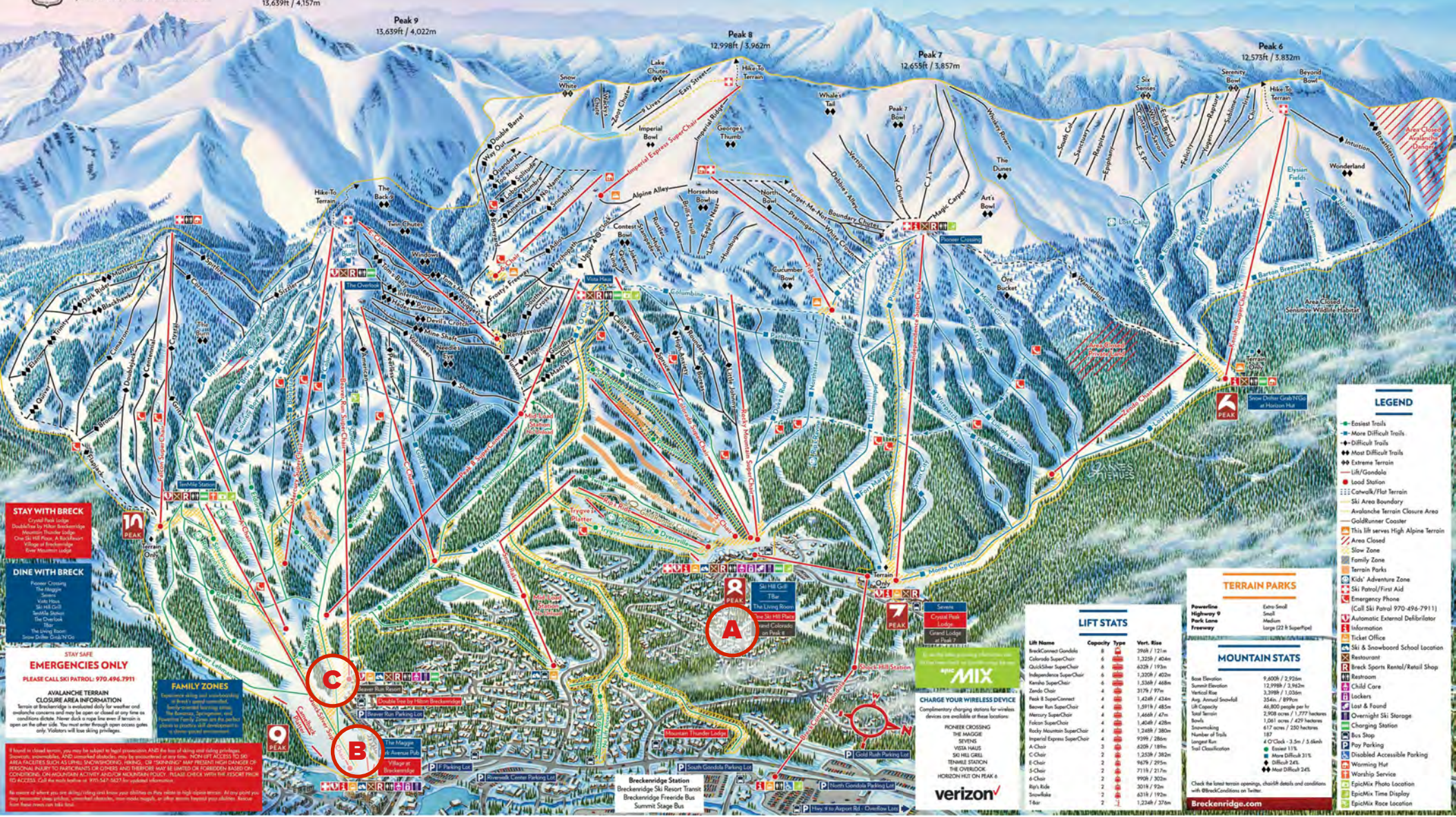
