Q. Is parking available at 360 CHICAGO?

A. Parking is available at 875 N Michigan Avenue's garage. Vehicle clearance is 6 feet 7 inches and is easily accessible from the Chestnut Street or Delaware Place side of the building. Daily rates are applicable.

Q. What are the best times to visit 360 CHICAGO Observation Deck?

A. 360 CHICAGO Observation Deck is open year-round, and the best times to visit are on clear days during the morning or evening when the sunlight provides the best views and the crowds are smaller. In the case of inclement weather, you'll will be advised about weather conditions and visibility before entering. Chicago does experience inconsistent weather conditions from time to time, but since they fluctuate and visibility can improve quickly, we advise that you arrive for your ticketed time!

Please visit the <u>360 CHICAGO website</u> to book your slot in advance of your visit. Book early to secure your preferred date and time, we recommend booking between 9AM and 2PM for the best availability.

You'll need your pass number and the email address you booked with to make a reservation, you'll need to book for each passholder in your group separately.

If you prefer to visit without a reservation, you can walk up to the box office with your pass to get the next available time slot. However, **this is strictly based on same-day availability and is NOT GUARANTEED.**

Changing your plans

Cancellations or amendments to your reservations can be made up until one hour before your scheduled booking time via the <u>360 Chicago booking page</u>. If you have an Explorer Pass and do not cancel or amend your reservation in time it will count as one of the choices on your pass.

Shedd Aquarium FAQS

Q. What is the Shedd Aquarium?

A. The Shedd Aquarium is a non-profit aquarium located in Chicago, Illinois that houses over 32,000 aquatic animals.

Q. Can I bring food into the aquarium?

A. No, outside food and beverages are not allowed inside the aquarium, but there are dining options available onsite.

Q. Is the aquarium accessible for individuals with disabilities?

A. Yes, the Shedd Aquarium is fully accessible and offers various accommodations for visitors with disabilities.

Q. Can I take photos and videos inside the aquarium?

A. Yes, personal photography and videography are allowed inside the aquarium, but commercial photography requires prior approval and an additional fee.

Hop-On Hop-Off Big Bus Chicago: 1-Day Discover Tour FAQs

Q. What is the Hop-On Hop-Off Big Bus Chicago: 1-Day Discover Tour?

A. The Hop-On Hop-Off Big Bus Chicago: 1-Day Discover Tour is a sightseeing tour that lets you explore the city's top attractions at your own pace.
