• Rose Center Entrance (81st St between Central Park West and Columbus Ave) and proceed downstairs to the Will Call window (Insider tip: this location often has shorter lines)

- **Gilde Center Entrance** (79th and Columbus Ave) and proceed to the ticketing desk (*Insider tip:* this location often has shorter lines)
- Main Entrance (79th St at Central Park West) and proceed to the ticketing desk

### Wheelchair accessibility

The Natural History Museum New York is fully accessible.

### Visitor tips

- Plan to spend around 2 hours 30 minutes at the Museum of Natural History, but reserve an extra hour if you intend to see a special exhibition.
- The museum doesn't allow food and drink, except for water bottles.

### **FAQs**

### How do I get to the American Museum of Natural History using public transportation?

The museum is easily accessible by public transportation. You can take the subway, bus, or even a commuter train. For subway access, take the B (weekdays only) or C trains to the 81st Street-Museum of Natural History station. Alternatively, you can take the 1 train to the 79th Street station and walk a few blocks west. Several bus routes also stop near the museum, including the M79 crosstown bus and the M7, M10, and M11 buses. For detailed directions, visit the museum's website or use a transit planning app.

### Can I bring my own food and drinks into the museum?

No, outside food and drinks are not allowed in the museum. However, there are several dining options available on-site, including the Museum Food Court, the Café on One, and the Café on Four. These eateries offer a variety of meals, snacks, and beverages to suit different tastes and dietary needs.

### Is the American Museum of Natural History wheelchair accessible?

Yes, the museum is committed to providing a comfortable and accessible experience for all visitors. All public floors, exhibits, and restrooms are wheelchair accessible, and there are elevators and ramps available. The museum also offers wheelchairs for visitors to borrow on a first-come, first-served basis at the entrance.
