The Empire State Building is fully ADA-compliant. There are accessible restrooms on the 86th Floor Observatory along with ramps, lowered viewing walls, and binoculars. Motorized and non-motorized wheelchairs are permitted.

### When was the Empire State Building completed?

The Empire State Building was completed on April 11, 1931.

Yes, the Empire State Building features two observation decks, located on the 86th and 102nd floors.

### How long did it take to construct the Empire State Building?

It took just 410 days, or about 14 months, to construct the Empire State Building.

### How many floors does the Empire State Building have?

The Empire State Building has a total of 102 floors above ground.

## What is the Empire State Building primarily used for?

The Empire State Building is mainly used as an office building and also houses the famous observation decks, a visitor center, and broadcast facilities.

A limited number of wheelchairs are available on both Liberty and Ellis Island for no fee, but on a first-come, first-served basis. You will need an ID to use as a deposit. Guide dogs are welcome. The buildings and grounds on Liberty Island are ADA compliant.

## Visitor tips

- You are allowed to bring your own food and drinks to both the islands but it must be sealed. Food and drinks are not allowed in the pedestal or crown of the Statue of Liberty.
- There are dining options on both islands, provided by Evelyn Hill Inc.

Beware of unauthorized agents posing as Statue of Liberty employees. Statue Cruises is included with your pass—a genuine agent will never ask you to pay for access.

The metal framework of the Statue of Liberty was built by Gustave Eiffel, who is known for building the Eiffel Tower.
