Tips for visiting the Empire State Building

- Per CDC guidelines, the Empire State Building Observatory requires all guests ages 2 and up to wear facial coverings.
- The Empire State Building has free WiFi throughout, so you can share your experience as you explore.
- When it comes to dining, drinks and snacks, there are several options. Take your pick from the STATE Grill and Bar, Tacombi, Starbucks and Sushi-Teria.
- Signage is available in nine languages English, Spanish, French, German, Italian, Portuguese, Japanese, Korean and Mandarin.
- You can watch the Empire State on a live earthcam view.
- The Empire State Building is fully ADA compliant. There are handicapped restrooms on the 86th-floor observatory along with ramps, lowered viewing walls and binoculars. Motorized and non-motorized wheelchairs are permitted.

Getting in: on arrival, please present your reservation confirmation, then proceed inside for entry. Scan your pass at the turnstile after security. That's it, you're in! Enjoy the view.

Please note: passes cannot be used to book sunset time slots. We suggest booking an evening time slot to enjoy sweeping views of Manhattan's city lights at night!

Tips for visiting the Top of the Rock Observation Deck

- Top of the Rock is open from 9AM to 12AM daily so you can visit day or night, sun up or sundown.
- Top of the Rock and the Rockefeller Center Tours are fully wheelchair accessible. There are handicapped restrooms at Top of The Rock. Licensed service dogs are welcome.
- Food and drinks are not permitted but there are plenty of dining options available at Rockefeller Center. Take your pick from a number of dining options in Rockefeller Center including Lodi, Del Frisco's Grille, Bill's Bar & Burger, Dough, Chip City, and FuKu.
- Be sure you leave time to <u>shop in Rockefeller Center</u> at iconic stores including FAO Schwarz, Nintendo, Kate Spade, NBC Store, LEGO, Mulberry, Cole Haan, and Michael Kors.

• Download the <u>Top of the Rock App</u> before your trip. It acts as a skyline guide and as an audio tour.

FAQS

Q. What is the Top of the Rock?

A. The Top of the Rock Observation Deck, located on the top three floors of Rockefeller Center in New York City, gives visitors breathtaking 360-degree views of the city skyline and beyond.

Q. How high is the Top of the Rock?

A. Standing at 850 feet, the Top of the Rock Observation Deck offers some of the best panoramic views in all of Manhattan.

Q. Where can I find tickets for Top of the Rock?

A. Tickets to visit the Top of the Rock Observation Deck are available online, directly from kiosks located outside 30 Rockefeller Plaza, or <u>included with **The New York Pass®**</u>

Q. How long does a visit to Top of the Rock last?

A: The average length for a visit to the Top of the Rock Observation Deck in NYC is about two hours, though you can stay as long as you would like!

Q. Are there other attractions associated with Top of the Rock?

A: Yes! You can check out multiple shops and restaurants located within 30 Rockefeller Plaza, including NBC Studios and Radio City Music Hall — both located just steps away from The Rainbow Room restaurant, offering three different levels with spectacular views!

Q. Are there any age restrictions on visiting Top of The Rock?

A: There are no age restrictions to enter; however all guests 16 years old or younger must be accompanied by an adult 21 years or older with valid ID at all times during their visit at Rockefeller Center's observation deck.

Getting in: use the Rockefeller Center entrance on 50th Street (between 5th and 6th Avenues) and go down the staircase to enter the pass redemption line. Present your valid pass for admission in the next available time slot. During busy periods like summer and the holidays, we recommend arriving between 9AM and 3PM for the shortest wait times. To enter Top of the Rock, proceed upstairs and through a security screening.

Time to kill before your admission slot? Why not get a few more things ticked off nearby while you wait! We recommend exploring the iconic FAO Schwarz toy store, St. Patrick's Cathedral, or the many Rockefeller Center shops and eateries.

Group tours: if you are traveling with a tour group, please send a tour group leader to exchange all passes for timed admission tickets between 10AM and 11AM on the day you plan to visit the observatory. Tour groups that arrive after 11AM without timed admission tickets may be turned away.

- Give yourself two hours to experience every exhibit at the museum.
- Food and drinks are not permitted inside the museum but there is a café inside the Museum Pavilion.
- The historical exhibition may not be suitable for children under the age of 10.
- A limited amount of wheelchairs are available on a first-come, first-served basis for no fee.

Getting your ticket: on the plaza between the Memorial and Museum, enter the box office line to redeem your pass for an admission time slot. During busy periods like summer and the holidays, we recommend visiting as early in the day as possible.

Time to kill before your admission slot? Why not get a few more things ticked off nearby while you wait! We recommend shopping and dining around the Oculus; a walk around Battery Park; a stroll down Wall Street; or the free Staten Island Ferry for views of the Statue of Liberty from the water.

Please note: your pass includes general admission to the 9/11 Memorial and Museum. Guided tours are available for an additional fee payable directly to the 9/11 Memorial & Museum.

FAQs

Q. What is One World Observatory?

A. One World Observatory is a 3-story destination located at the top of the western hemisphere's tallest building, One World Trade Center. It offers visitors an unparalleled view of New York City and beyond.

Q. How do I get to One World Observatory?

A. You can get to One World Observatory by taking a Sky Pod elevator from the ground floor of One World Trade Center to the 102nd floor in just 47 seconds!

Q. What can I do at One World Observatory?

A. At One World Observatory, you can explore interactive exhibits that tell the story of New York City, enjoy 360-degree views from the highest observation deck in NYC, and even dine at ONE Dine restaurant for an unforgettable experience!

Q. Are there any discount tickets available for visiting One World Observatory?

A. Yes! Discounts are available for groups of 10 or more people, seniors (ages 65+), active military personnel, students with valid IDs, and children ages 6-12 years old when tickets are purchased online in advance. Entry is also included with The New York Pass®, which gives you access to 100+ of NYC's top attractions.

Q. Is there anything else I should know before visiting the New York One World Observatory?

A. Yes! To ensure your safety and comfort during your visit, all guests must go through security screening before entering the observatory. Bags may be subject to search upon entry and throughout your visit. Additionally, please note that strollers are not permitted inside the observatory due to space limitations on the elevators and observation decks.

Getting your ticket: visit any kiosk to scan your pass and reserve your entry in the next available time slot. Save the printed ticket! When it's time to enter, simply present the ticket and proceed through a security screening.

Time to kill before your admission slot? Why not get a few more things ticked off nearby while you wait! We recommend shopping and dining around the Oculus; a walk around Battery Park; a stroll down Wall Street; or the free Staten Island Ferry for views of the Statue of Liberty from the water.

- A limited number of wheelchairs are available on both Liberty and Ellis Island for no fee, but on a first-come, first-served basis. You will need an ID to use as a deposit.
- Guide dogs are welcome.
- The buildings and grounds on Liberty Island are ADA compliant.
- You are allowed to bring your own food and drinks to both the islands but it must be sealed. Food and drinks are not allowed in the pedestal or crown areas.
- There are dining options on both islands.

Getting in: present your pass at the 'reserve ticket' entrance at your chosen depature point (remember that your pass must be valid when scanned at the time of your visit). Proceed through the security screening facility before boarding the ferry.

Please note: access to the pedestal and crown of the Statue of Liberty is not included with your pass. If you wish to add access to those parts of the statue, you will need book 'Crown Reserve' and/or 'Pedestal Reserve' tickets independently, and make reservations as soon as possible as space is limited and tours often sell out months in advance.

Children under four years old are admitted for free.

American Museum of Natural History

Tips for visiting the American Museum of Natural History

- The Natural History Museum New York is fully accessible.
- Consult the map of the museum to plan which exhibitions to see.
- Plan to spend around 2 hours 30 minutes at the Museum of Natural History, but reserve an extra hour if you intend to see a special exhibition.
- The museum doesn't allow food and drink, except for water bottles.
- Leave large bags behind at the hotel or you will have to leave them at Coat Check for an additional \$2 charge per item.

FAQs

Q. What are the highlights of the American Museum of Natural History?

A. The museum features a vast collection of exhibits, including the Rose Center for Earth and Space, the Hayden Planetarium, the Milstein Hall of Ocean Life, the Hall of Human Origins, and the Hall of Dinosaurs, among many others. Some of the standout displays include the blue whale model, the T-Rex skeleton, and the Willamette Meteorite.

Q. Are guided tours available at the American Museum of Natural History?

A. Yes, guided tours are available for both individuals and groups. The museum offers a variety of themed tours led by knowledgeable guides. Some popular options include the Highlights

Tour, the Night at the Museum Tour, and the Dino Tour. For more information, visit the museum's website or inquire at the information desk upon arrival.

Q. Can I bring my own food and drinks into the museum?

A. No, outside food and drinks are not allowed in the museum. However, there are several dining options available on-site, including the Museum Food Court, the Café on One, and the Café on Four. These eateries offer a variety of meals, snacks, and beverages to suit different tastes and dietary needs.

Q. Are there any special events or programs offered at the American Museum of Natural History?

A. Yes, the museum hosts a variety of special events and programs throughout the year. These include lectures, workshops, film screenings, and special exhibitions. Additionally, the museum offers educational programs and resources for families, students, and teachers. For a schedule of upcoming events and programs, visit the museum's website or check their social media channels.

Q. Is the American Museum of Natural History wheelchair accessible?

A. Yes, the museum is committed to providing a comfortable and accessible experience for all visitors. All public floors, exhibits, and restrooms are wheelchair accessible, and there are elevators and ramps available. The museum also offers wheelchairs for visitors to borrow on a first-come, first-served basis at the entrance.

Q. How do I get to the American Museum of Natural History using public transportation?

A. The museum is easily accessible by public transportation. You can take the subway, bus, or even a commuter train. For subway access, take the B (weekdays only) or C trains to the 81st Street-Museum of Natural History station. Alternatively, you can take the 1 train to the 79th Street station and walk a few blocks west. Several bus routes also stop near the museum, including the M79 crosstown bus and the M7, M10, and M11 buses. For detailed directions, visit the museum's website or use a transit planning app.

Q. What is the Pay What You Wish policy for local residents?

A. If you are a resident of New York, New Jersey or Connecticut, the amount you pay for General Admission to the Museum is up to you and includes access to more than 40 permanent exhibition halls, the Rose Center for Earth and Space, and the Richard Gilder Center for Science, Education, and Innovation. Please note that General Admission does not include ticketed exhibitions, the butterfly vivarium, the giant-screen film, and Hayden Planetarium Space Show.

Getting in: please present your valid pass for scanning to receive entrance at either of these two locations:

- 1. Rose Center entrance (81st St between Central Park West and Columbus Ave) and proceed downstairs to the Will Call window (*Insider tip:* this location often has shorter lines)
- 2. Main entrance (79th St at Central Park West) and proceed to the vouchers desk

Optional extras: your pass entitles you to free general admission only. If you would like to upgrade your admission ticket to include a temporary exhibit, IMAX or 3D film, OR a Hayden Planetarium Space Show, you may do so for an additional fee directly at the museum.

Tips for visiting MoMA NYC

- The morning is the most crowded time to visit. We suggest visiting during an alternate time.
- MoMA is accessible and wheelchairs are available on a first-come, first-served basis and are free of charge.
- Our checkroom is currently closed. Scooters, skateboards, rolling bags, and all items over 11×17×5" [28×43×13 cm] are not permitted in the Museum. All bags will be inspected upon arrival. Please wear backpacks on the front of your chest or carry them to the side.
- Photography is permitted, but video is not.
- There are dining opportunities within the museum including The Modern restaurant, Café 2, and The Terrace Cafe.

- Connect to MoMA NYC's free WiFi and get access to the museum's digital map and audio guides. Charging stations are also provided throughout the Museum.
- Join artists, curators, and creative thinkers for conversations and workshops in the Crown Creativity Lab, MoMA's new participatory space on Floor 2; or visit the family-friendly Art Lab.

FAQs

Q. What is the Museum of Modern Art (MOMA)?

A. The Museum of Modern Art (MOMA) is one of the world's largest and most influential modern art museums, located in Midtown Manhattan in New York City. MOMA houses an impressive collection of artwork from the mid-19th century to the present day, including classics such as Monet, van Gogh and Picasso.

Q. Where is MOMA located?

A. The Museum of Modern Art (MOMA) is located at 11 West 53rd Street between 5th & 6th Avenues in Midtown Manhattan.

Q. When is MOMA open?

A. The Museum of Modern Art (MOMA) is open seven days a week from 10:30am to 5:30pm, Thursdays until 8pm, and closed on Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day..

Q. How much are tickets to MOMA?

A. General admission tickets start at \$25 for adults, and include access to galleries and exhibitions as well as audio guides available in both English and Spanish languages. You can also get access to MOMA and 100+ NYC attractions with The New York Pass®.

Q Can I take photos inside the museum?

A. Yes! All visitors are allowed to take photos inside the museum except for certain restricted areas designated by staff or security guards throughout the premises – please do not hesitate to ask if you're unsure where photography is allowed or not permitted!

Q What else can I do while visiting MOMA?

A. Aside from admiring amazing artwork collections on display, visitors can also enjoy shopping at various bookstores or gift shops that are found throughout the museum or participate in various educational tours held by expert docents!

Getting in: once you arrive at the Museum, proceed through a security inspection. Scan your pass at any kiosk on the left side of the lobby to receive a printed ticket. Show your printed tickets at the gallery entrance for admission.

Please note: Children ages 16 and under receive free general admission.

Q. Can I take photos inside the museum?

A. Yes! All visitors are allowed to take photos and videos inside the museum, however there are some restrictions in certain areas like the Marvel 4D theater where photography or videos are not allowed due to copyright laws and safety restrictions in place during the show performances.

Q What else can I do while visiting Madame Tussauds?

A. There's plenty to do besides admiring wax figures at Madame Tussauds! The museum offers interactive experiences such as a live-action movie stunt show and a virtual reality ghost hunt ride hosted by Bill & Ted's Excellent Adventure; a special Marvel Super Heroes exhibit featuring 3D fun rides; as well as themed drink specials at select bars throughout the museum grounds!
